FINANCIAL AID INFORMATION

What Is it?

Financial Aid is money given, loaned, or paid to students to help them pay for college costs. The money comes from federal, state, college, and private funds.

Financial Aid includes: Grants and Scholarships, which do not have to be repaid
Loans, which must be repaid
Work-Study, an hourly wage for part-time work

Am I Eligible?

To find out, you need to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.ed.gov , and be accepted into an approved program.

Note: The application is free – if someone is charging a fee for the FAFSA, you are at the wrong website!

How To Apply? To start, you need an email address. If you don't have one, get one (free!) at www.google.com or www.yahoo.com .

Gather together your and your parents' previous year financial information: tax returns, W2 forms, and information about non-taxable income.

Go to www.fafsa.ed.gov and complete the FAFSA. Include Great Bay's school code – 002583.

Then What?

If you have been admitted to Great Bay, and have completed the FAFSA, the Financial Aid Office will send you an Award Letter, listing the financial aid for which you qualify.

Note: You may be asked for additional information before getting an Award Letter.
