In 1989, Crotched Mountain established a foundation to provide small grants to low and moderate income New Hampshire residents with disabilities for products and services not funded elsewhere. Since then, the Harry Gregg Foundation (HGF), established in honor of the founder of Crotched Mountain, has made over 8,000 grants totaling more than \$3 million. The foundation is unusual in that it provides funds to people, not organizations, and is one of the few in the state that does so.
