Immediate Basic Needs

Local Welfare

Applications for temporary assistance with current needs for basic living costs (such as shelter, electricity, heating fuel, and food) can be obtained and completed at your local city or town hall.

The way that local welfare law applies in various cases is complex, as it involves a number of variables that may differ substantially in specific situations.

Share Fund

The Share fund may be able to help with basic needs when local welfare cannot. Typically, you will need to apply for local welfare assistance and get a letter of decision that shows that you are not eligible for the aid that you need from your city or town before Share can assist.
