The goal of the program is to prepare competent entry-level surgical technologists with the knowledge, skills, and behaviors required for success in their careers. Only 20 students are accepted into this competitive program. Prior to graduation, students will sit for the national certification exam by taking a nationally administered written exam through the National Board of Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting (NBSTSA).

The Surgical Technology Program starts only in the fall semester.



Surgical Technology Admissions Requirements:

Application must be **COMPLETED** by **April 1st** to be considered for the Fall class.

- 1. Complete application to the program.
- 2. Provide official HS transcript or equivalent and prior college, if applicable/seeking transfer credit.
- 3. Must have completed HS level or equivalent Biology with a "C" or better or provide proof of current enrollment. Computer background is strongly recommended.
- 4. Place into college level Math, Reading and Writing or demonstrate equivalent competencies through college transcript or SAT scores.
