## Associate in Science

Great Bay's Technical Studies program provides pathways for skilled workers to earn an Associate Degrees by offering credit for recognized, technical specialties. The program allows students to build on previous success in areas of technical expertise through the choice of electives that complement the technical specialties and is designed as an individualized program of study in an area not otherwise offered at the College.

Students coming from recognized apprenticeship programs or students with certifications in a technical field (in an area that we do not offer an Associate Degree) may receive credits toward an Associate's degree in Technical Studies.



### Admissions Criteria:

1. Complete application to the program.
2. Provide official HS transcript or equivalent (GED/HiSet scores) and prior college, if applicable and seeking transfer credit.
3. Applicants must receive approval from Academic Affairs to participate in this program.
