## Financial Aid at GBCC

### What Is It?

Financial Aid provides funds for direct and indirect college expenses. Direct expenses are generally those expenses charged directly to your student account, such as tuition and fees. Indirect expenses are those you pay for out-of-pocket such as for books and transportation to and from college.

Financial Aid includes:

- Grants and Scholarships, which do not have to be repaid; usually based on need
- Loans, which must be repaid; loan type is based on need
- Work-Study, an hourly wage for part-time work

### Am I Eligible?

To find out, you need to complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov), and be accepted into an approved program.

### How To Apply?

**Entering Fall 2020 or Spring 2021**

Submit the 2020-2021 FAFSA online

*Requires 2018 income information*

Gather your and/or your parents' or your spouse's financial information, such as tax returns, W2 forms, and information about non-taxable income.
