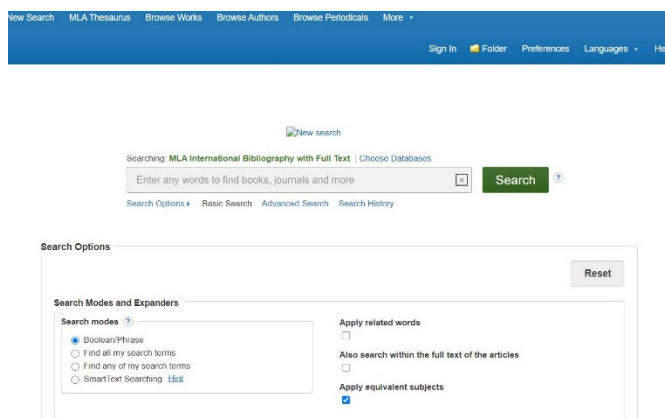


MLA International Bibliography



From the Modern Language Association (MLA) and EBSCO, this resource combines an extensive collection of 789 full-text journals for the study and teaching of language, literature, linguistics, rhetoric, writing studies, folklore, film, theater, and other dramatic arts.

1. Go to <https://search.ebscohost.com/login.aspx?authtype=ip,athens&custid=stratham&groupid=main&profile=ehost&defaultdb=mlf> For off campus login, use your college **email username** and **password**.



2. On the **basic search** page, enter your search terms and select limitations such as **full text**, **scholarly (peer-reviewed) journals**, **genre**, **language**, or **date**. You can also choose whether to search for any or all of your terms or to search for related words.

3. You will be able to filter results by **date** and **source type** by using the **Refine Results** tools in the left sidebar.

4. Click the title of a result to view more detailed information. The left sidebar contains the link for the article's **Full Text**. If the result is a book that cannot be viewed online, contact the Library staff for assistance requesting an **Interlibrary Loan**.
5. Click the **Cite** button on the right side of the page to view a citation in **APA**, **MLA**, or **Chicago** format. You can also **Print** the article or **Email** the whole article or just the citation to yourself.
