### **Transfer Scholarships are Available:**

### For students transferring to any UNH degree program:

Associates Degree Transfer Scholarships. Full-time students transferring to UNH from any associates degree program with at least 24 transferrable credits and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher are eligible to receive a transfer scholarship of \$3,000/year, renewable for up to three years. Associates Degree Transfer Achievement Scholarships. Incoming students transferring to UNH with a completed associates degree and a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher are eligible to receive a transfer scholarship of \$5,000/year, renewable for up to three years. The Granite Guarantee. The Granite Guarantee covers the cost of tuition for Pell-eligible students transferring as full-time students to UNH, from any campus of the Community College System of New Hampshire. Students must be New Hampshire residents and must be transferring directly. This program bridges the financial gap between a Pell Grant recipient's total federal and state aid package and the cost of in-state tuition. Qualified students must be enrolled full-time. ## For students transferring to programs in the UNH College of Life Sciences and Agriculture (COLSA):

### Pathways to Professions in the Biosciences Transfer Scholarships.

Each year, graduating GBCC students transferring to biological science-related degree programs in the College of Life Science and Agriculture at UNH are eligible to apply for a P2P Transfer Scholarship. Awarded on the basis of merit and need, up to ten scholarships of up to \$10,000 each are awarded each year. P2P scholarships are renewable for a second year upon successful completion the first and are funded by the National Science Foundation S-STEM program.

#### Did You Know...

Tuition at UNH for 64 credits (four semesters of full-time study) can cost upwards of \$38,000\*. At GBCC, tuition for 64 credits is only \$13,760\*\*. By following one of our approved pathways, that's almost three times less than doing the equivalent course work at UNH, and the credits are transferrable! In addition, at GBCC you'll find a college that's close by, affordable, known for teaching excellence, small classes and a community dedicated to student success.
