Make a difference as a Certified Phlebotomy Technician!

Phlebotomist Technicians are key members in hospitals, diagnostic laboratories and blood donor centers.

During this 8-week (64-hours) program, you will learn (not limited to) drawing blood, evaluating a patient's ability to withstand the procedure and help them feel comfortable, explaining the blood-drawing procedure to patients and answering questions, preparing blood, urine and other specimens for testing and maintaining medical equipment such as needles, test tubes and blood vials. At the conclusion of the program, you will be well prepared for the Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT) certification exam through the National Healthcareer Association (NHA).

After successful completion of the program and national certification for Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT) you will be able to apply for jobs in hospitals, clinics, laboratories, blood donation centers and other healthcare facilities. You may also work in mobile blood donation units or in-home healthcare settings.



Job Outlook

Employment is projected to experience a 8% increase from 2022-2032, faster than the average for all occupations.

In June 2024, the mean annual wage for phlebotomists in NH was \$40,561.

Application Requirements:

- Age 18 & older
- High School Diploma, GED or HiSet
- Completed Application and Resume
- Interview
- Proof of Hepatitis B (10 days prior to start of class)

Course Curriculum:

Classroom: 64 hours, 8 weeks, 4 hours/day

This course provides theoretical, interpersonal, as well as clinical skills. You will gain experience with drawing blood and finger pricks, skills needed to obtain employment as a phlebotomy technician or specimen processing technician.
